



## **Home Buyers Education**

Home buyers who participate in any State Housing Initiative Partnership (SHIP) programs are required to successfully complete a homebuyer education course as one of various qualification steps to receive down payment/closing cost/and rehabilitation assistance. The objective of the course is to provide first-time home buyers with general information about the process of buying a home. At the end of the course, the participants are provided with a certificate of completion. Alachua County Housing Programs requires participants to obtain a home buyers education certificate from one of the following HUD approved agencies:
