What is Alachua County Government Minimum Wage?

Ordinance No. 16-05 – Alachua County Government Minimum Wage (GMW) – A contractor, or subcontractor, providing a covered service to the County shall pay to all of its covered employees no less than the established Alachua County Government Minimum Wage.

What if You're Not Paid the GMW?
